All Adams 12 Five Star Schools families are encouraged to apply for school meal benefits.

BENEFITS OF APPLYING FOR FAMILIES

- Qualifying families will receive school meal benefits for the 2020-2021 school year.
- School fees can be waived or reduced, such as athletic fees, and activity and field trip fees tied to curriculum.
- Families can qualify for additional assistance, such as medical, food and cash assistance.
- Families can also qualify for support with other services, such as internet, gym memberships, passes to museums and cultural events.

BENEFITS OF APPLYING FOR SCHOOL

- Free and reduced percentage determines if a school has a breakfast after the bell program.
- Assists your child's school in receiving additional funding.

REMINDER

- Families **must reapply** for free and reduced-price school meals each new year.
- All students that were approved for school meal benefits for 2019-2020 will receive the same school meal benefits for the first 30 meal serve days of the new school year or until a new eligibility determination is made.
- United States citizenship or immigration status is not a condition of eligibility for free and reduced price meal benefits.





Applications will be processed as quickly as possible. Keep in mind, online applications process faster.

Due to the high volume of applications, please allow up to 10 operating days for a response. You will receive your eligibility letter in the mail or by email. Parents must pay full price for meals until the application is approved.
